

# THE MUSEUM The River Ave Valley Te:

The River Ave Valley Textile Industry Museum was founded in 1987 as a research project on industrial archaeology to study the history of the industrialisation of the Ave Valley and preserve its industrial heritage. The Museum offers society numerous services such as regular publications (e. g., the annual scientific review Arqueologia Industrial, published since 1987, the most important of its type in Portugal), exhibitions, the conservation and restoration of industrial archaeological artifacts, collection and conservation of historical documentation, seminars, conferences and courses on the industrial heritage, an educational service, a specialized library, shop, scholarly research, etc.



### A FASCINATING DISPLAY OF AUTHENTIC WORKING TEXTILE MACHINERY

The River Ave Valley Textile Industry Museum is an industrial archaeological museum, displaying a fascinating and comprehensive collection of authentic working textile machinery. Demonstrators operating the machines explain textile techniques like spinning, weaving, knitting, dyeing and confection.

### THE RIVER AVE VALLEY

Situated in the Nortwest Portugal, the Ave Valley is an area thoroughly shaped by the cotton textile industry, whose very first mill was founded there in 1845. One of the main reasons for the flourishment of the industry was owed to the search for water power to operate the mills. Since then, the textile industry has made up its principal economic activity — chiefly in the counties of Fafe, Guimarães, Vila Nova de Famalicão and Santo Tirso —, and nowadays is the most important textile region in Portugal.
